¹ The School of Arts and Sciences at Gwynedd Mercy University has a minimum residency requirement of 50 credits for all students transferring into a traditional, term-based bachelor's degree program, and at least half of the credits required for the major must be completed at GMercyU. The BSW Program requires 120 credits; the total number of transfer credits may not exceed 70. In addition to the 64 credits outlined above, students may transfer up to 2 additional courses (6 credits) toward their BSW degree, either as general education requirements/electives or to satisfy BSW major requirements. For the latter, GMercyU recommends Introduction to Youth and Family and/or a diversity class.
