Exam Passage Rates

December 2024 graduates were asked about their plans regarding licensure and certification exams. 72.7% of the students indicated they had not yet taken the National Counselor Exam (NCE) but planned to do so. 18.2% indicated they had taken the exam and passed, and the remaining respondents reported they did not intend to take the exam. 28.6% of the students reported that they took and passed the Praxis Professional School Counselor Exam. One student indicated they took the exam and did not pass, while one student reported they had plans to take the exam in the future. 61.9% of students reported they do not intend to take the Praxis exam.

May 2025 graduates were asked about their plans regarding licensure and certification. One student reported they had taken and passed the NCE, while the remaining four indicated they had not yet taken the exam but planned to do so. Two students indicated they had taken and passed the Praxis Professional School Counselor Exam, and the remaining three indicated they had not yet taken the exam but planned to do so.

Program Attrition

In 2024-25, there were four student-initiated withdrawals, two administrative withdrawals, and one dismissal.

Job Placement Information

When asked about post-graduation employment plans, 50% of the December graduates reported that they had already secured employment in counseling or a related field, while the other 50% were currently searching for a position or did not plan to pursue a position in the counseling field.

May 2025 graduates were also asked about post-graduation employment plans. One student indicated they had already accepted an offer as a school counselor, while three are currently searching for counseling positions. One student indicated they do not plan to search for a counseling position.
