

## Estimated Cost of Attendance for GMercyU’s MSOT Program

The Occupational Therapy Program at Gwynedd Mercy University offers two tracks. The following are all **estimated** costs for each track; [confirmed tuition and fees](#) for 2026-2027 will be available in spring 2026, and fees are subject to change.

### 1. 3+2 Dual Degree Occupational Science and Occupational Therapy

Students in this track complete a Bachelor of Health Science (BHS) in Occupational Science and some graduate courses at undergraduate tuition rates. Graduates of the bachelor’s degree then complete only **one year** of courses at graduate tuition rates to earn their MSOT degree, a significant savings in time and tuition. Based on [estimated future tuition and fees](#), these are the estimated costs associated with completing one year of graduate study to complete the MSOT program in 2026-2027. They do not include the tuition and fees associated with the undergraduate degree in Occupational Science.

### 2. Post-Baccalaureate Graduate Student Track (2 Years)

In this traditional graduate student track, students complete all 77 credits of the MSOT degree as a graduate student. Based on [estimated future tuition and fees](#), these are the costs associated with enrolling in the MSOT program for two years, 2026-2028.
